Dear Friends,

One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us the opportunity to look back and be thankful for all that has been accomplished. The past fiscal year was filled with wonderful opportunities and many challenges. Some of the highlights were:

- HODS has been named an accredited charity by the Better Business Bureau.
- HODS enabled a number of Jewish families to donate organs saving dozens of lives.
- HODS received a grant from the LiveOnNY Foundation for five college/university students in the New York area to become student ambassadors for HODS.
- HODS received a grant from the LiveOnNY Foundation to fund one animation video in four languages about brain death.
- HODS representatives delivered 20 lectures on Jewish law and organ donation to groups in USA, Australia, India, Israel, and the United Kingdom reaching hundreds of people.
